



# PRM charge

(for the service of disabled persons and persons with reduced mobility travelling by air at Międzynarodowy Port Lotniczy im. Jana Pawła II Kraków – Balice, pursuant to REGULATION (EC) No 1107/2006 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of 5 July 2006).

# PRM charge

(for the service of disabled persons and persons with reduced mobility travelling by air at Międzynarodowy Port Lotniczy im. Jana Pawła II Kraków – Balice, pursuant to REGULATION (EC) No 1107/2006 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of 5 July 2006).

Regulation (EC) No 1107/2006 OF THE EUROPEAN PARLIAMENT AND OF THE COUNCIL of 5 July 2006 obliges the airport managing entity to introduce a policy of protecting and assisting disabled persons and persons with reduced mobility travelling by air, in order to protect them against discrimination and provide necessary assistance at the airport.

In order to perform the obligation imposed on the airport managing entity in the Regulation, the Management Board of Międzynarodowy Port Lotniczy im. Jana Pawła II Kraków-Balice Sp. z o.o. has concluded an agreement with a handling agent WELCOME Airport Services Sp. z o.o., and thereby contracted the performance of the aforementioned obligation to the handling agent. The selection of the company was made basing on the outcome of procedure MPL/PF/FZ/241/3/03/20, carried out under Article 22 of "MPL Public Procurement Awarding Regulations" and in accordance with the Resolution 45/132/16 of the Management Board of Międzynarodowy Port Lotniczy im. Jana Pawła II Kraków-Balice Sp. z o.o. of 18.10.2016.

In connection with the above, the managing entity of Międzynarodowy Port Lotniczy im. Jana Pawła II Kraków-Balice assumes responsibility for providing disabled persons and persons with reduced mobility the assistance described in Appendix 1 to the Regulation, at no extra charge.

Under the Regulation the assistance should be financed in such manner as to fairly distribute the burden among all passengers using the airport. The airport managing entity may, on a non-discriminatory basis, levy a specific charge on airport users for the purpose of funding this assistance. The charge shall be shared among airport users in proportion to the total number of all passengers that each carries to and from that airport.

Międzynarodowy Port Lotniczy im. Jana Pawła II Kraków-Balice Sp. z o.o., acting on the basis of article 8 section 3 of the Regulation, introduces a PRM charge which will be charged from all airlines. The amount of that charge is related to the costs of handling disabled persons and persons with reduced mobility travelling by air, it is transparent and it does not serve the purpose of financing the operation of the managing entity.

The PRM charge at Międzynarodowy Port Lotniczy im. Jana Pawła II Kraków-Balice has been established at **PLN 0,45 for each departing passenger**. The charge is **effective as of 1 January 2021**. Passengers named in Section 5.2 of the Tariff for Aerodrome

Services of Międzynarodowy Port Lotniczy im. Jana Pawła II Kraków-Balice are exempt from the charge.

The PRM charge will be reviewed at the end of each calendar year. The difference between the assumed costs of handling of disabled persons and persons with reduced mobility travelling by air and the actual costs will be taken into account in establishing the PRM charge for the next calendar year.

Settlement of PRM charges shall be performed in accordance with Section 2. of the Tariff for Aerodrome Services of Międzynarodowy Port Lotniczy im. Jana Pawła II Kraków-Balice.

In order to ensure the highest possible standard of rendered services in handling disabled persons and persons with reduced mobility travelling by air, a Code of Good Practice in Handling Persons with Reduced Mobility at Kraków Airport has been drafted and approved in cooperation with the Kraków Airline Operators Committee (AOC KRK).
